LOCAL AREA ISSUANCE NO. 2009-03, Change 1

SUBJECT: Local Area Transition Plan Modification #4 Instructions for Program Year 2009 under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998 (Public Law 105-220).

PURPOSE: To transmit Program Year (PY) 2009 Local Area allocations for incorporation into PY 2009 Plan Instructions.

BACKGROUND: The U.S. Department of Labor released WIA allotments for PY 2009 (July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2010) for Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Activities on May 7, 2009. The State allotments are based on the funds appropriated in the U.S. Department of Labor Title I of the Omnibus Appropriations Act, 2009, Public Law 111-8, signed into law March 11, 2009.

The Division is releasing the attached amounts as Program Year 2009 Local Area allocations. Please note that local areas are expected to spend PY 2009 funds concurrently with Recovery Act funding to increase the availability of services quickly and effectively. Youth funds may not be transferred. Currently, the Appropriations Act, 2009, allows for the transfer of Adult and Dislocated Worker funds to be 30 percent. However, North Carolina has re-applied for a waiver to allow for a transfer of 100 percent between Adult and Dislocated Worker funds. Once notification is received from the U.S. Department of Labor, such transfers may take place.

ACTION:

The attached charts provide the July and October portions of the Program Year 2009 Local Area Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth allocations. The charts should be incorporated into the Local Area Transition Plan Modification #4, Section Attachment H (Allocations), and be used for planning and operating their Program Year 2009 WIA programs.

Local Workforce Development Areas should prepare and submit an Administrative Adjustment to incorporate the July portion of Program Year 2009 allocations into the Program Year 2009 Transition Plan Modification #4.

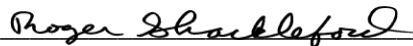
