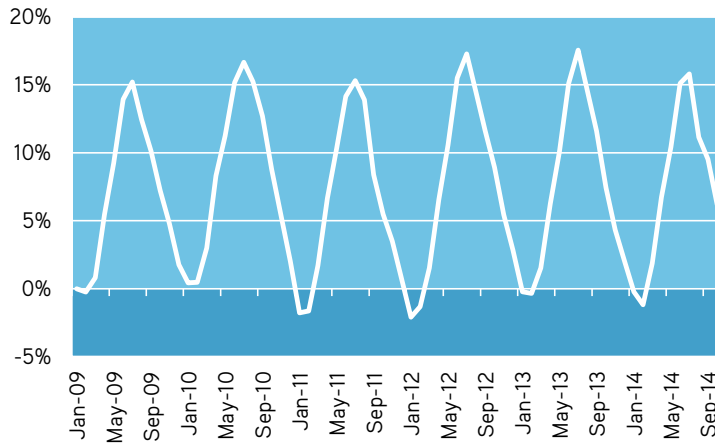

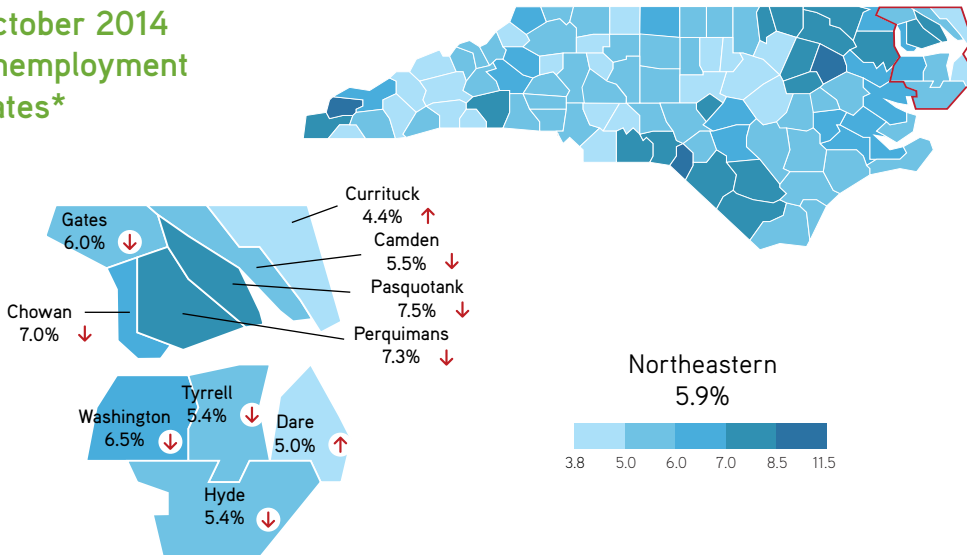
Regional Labor Market Snapshot
