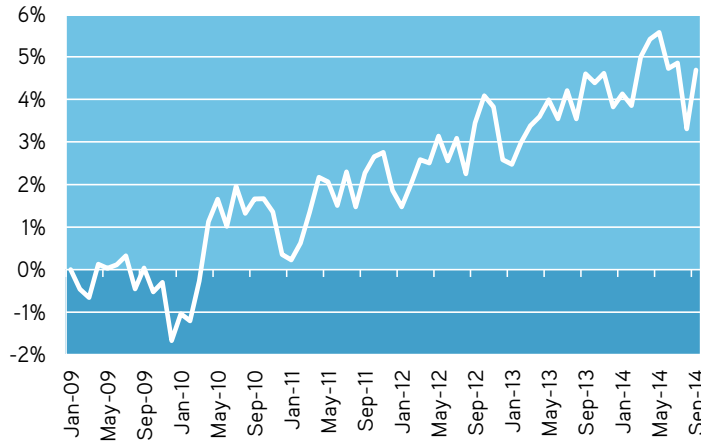


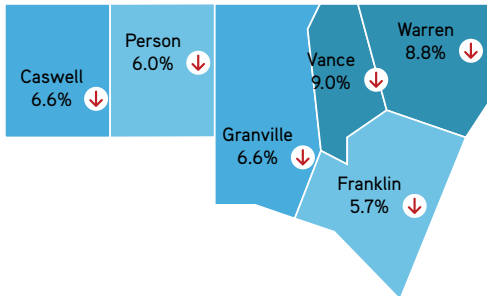
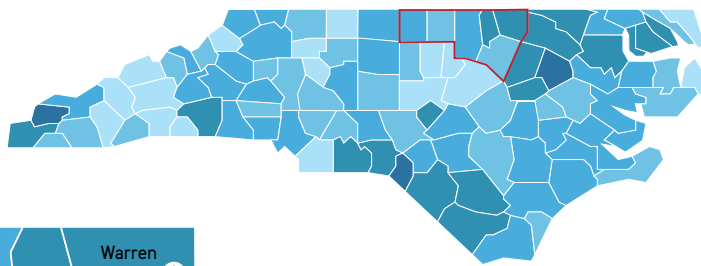
Regional Labor Market Snapshot
