

NC TODAY

July marked the 8-year anniversary of economic growth according to the National Bureau of Economic Research. Much has improved between Julys (2009 vs 2017): Unemployment Rate (10.7% to 4.1%); Unemployed (490,000 to 200,000); Non-Farm Employment (3.9 million to 4.4 million). While the expansion has been slow overall and uneven across all areas, it remains the 2nd longest of all time (to the 1990s). If the Philly Fed's Leading Indicator Index is correct, the expansion won't be ending soon. NC's index score was its highest in nearly four years, and 12th strongest among states for June.

Unemployment Rate Trend




Unemployment Rate Comparison


