### **Scoping Statements**

<u>Infrastructure</u>: The physical infrastructure relating to the construction, installation, and onshoring of power with a goal of advancing projects while mitigating environmental and natural resource impacts

<u>Environmental Justice</u>: The fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, national origin, or income with respect to the development, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies

<u>Inclusion:</u> The principle by which the OSW sector shall engage industry, communities, and stakeholders\*
