


About NC's preliminary unemployment rate (UR) and jobs numbers for June: 4.2% is the lowest level for NC since November 2000 – two recessions ago; it's the first time the UR has dipped below the U.S. rate in nearly three years; the UR has dropped 1.0 percentage points since December – the fastest six-month decline since August '13-February '14; the estimated 27,800 new jobs added in the past two months are more than any two-month period since spring 2014. Some adjustment of these numbers is to be expected; but combined with other economic data, NC appears to be in good shape heading into the second half of the year.

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









Average Real Weekly Earnings (Private Nonfarm Sector)






Labor Force Participation Rate



Residential Building Permits




Unemployment Rate By County (Not Seasonally Adjusted)




Real Taxable Retail Sales
