

2. Example helping a job seeker with occupation find possible industries and wage information.

Steps to find possible industries and wages

1. Get SOC code down (visit O*NET: <u>https://www.onetonline.org/</u> and use search box in upper right)

2. Industries- go to Staffing Patterns (by Occupation) https://tools.nccareers.org/

3. Wages- follow steps on next slide

Look for wages in area

Use Occupational Employment & Wage Statistics (OEWS)

D4 (<u>https://d4.nccommerce.com</u>)

Remember WTP (wage, latest, place- where is my place?)

Choose State or Metro area* or Nonmetro
