Low Flow Plumbing Fixtures

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform grantees of new requirements for all plumbing fixtures and fittings installed in units rehabilitated with CDBG funds.

Recently, several areas of our state have been affected by severe drought conditions. Many of our grantees have experienced water shortages and have imposed water restrictions. Therefore, in order to assist our grantees and to promote water conservation efforts, the Division of Community Assistance (DCA) has revised the Housing Rehabilitation Standards. In Section 16.2, "Fixtures", DCA requires:

All plumbing fixtures and fittings to meet the requirements of the table below. This revision is to include all fixtures and fittings as defined in the work write up.

Maximum Flow Rates and Consumption for Plumbing Fixtures and Fittings

Plumbing Fixtures or Fittings

Lavatory Faucet Shower Head Sink Faucet Water Closet

Rate Consumption 2.2 gpm at 60 psi.

2.5 gpm at 80 psi 2.2 gpm at 60 psi.

1.6 gal. per flushing cycle
