Certified Career Pathways are integrated, seamless systems of education and workforce development programs developed by engaged employers, workforce development boards, high schools and colleges. They are designed to match worker preparation to employer need.

The Mountain Area Workforce Development Board has three Career Pathways certified by the NCWorks Commission for the Advanced Manufacturing, Healthcare, and Hospitality & Tourism sectors. The region has the first pathway in the state certified by the NCWorks Commission for the Hospitality & Tourism sector. The region's development of career pathways have been a collaborative effort between employers, educators (K12, community colleges, and universities) and workforce partners.
